MADISON, WI (April, 2014)— Madisonians eager for the smell of summer grilling and the sound of live music in the air don't have to wait much longer. The 32nd annual World's Largest Brat Fest will kick off summer fun on Memorial Day Weekend, May 23–26, at Willow Island on the grounds of the Alliant Energy Center.

In 2013, Brat Fest broke the world record for preparing and serving the longest brat. More than that, and with the help of thousands of volunteers, Brat Fest has collectively donated more than \$1.3 million to local charities, making it an important charity event in Madison.
